This program is designed to prepare students for coaching positions in grades 7 to 12.

Head and assistant coaches are in increasing demand in the State of Minnesota, as well as around the country. This minor is usually combined with a teaching degree, making the candidate even stronger for teaching positions.

Faculty credentials
