TIMELINE

Election Timeline

- January 11 (first day of spring semester) - Candidacy application made available
- 2 Officially Scheduled and Public Rules Readings to be held in the student government office (CSU)
 - Further rules readings can be set up for individuals and parties by contacting the Elections Commission Chair at Ryan.Walfoort@mnsu.edu
- March 26 – Campaigning Begins
 - Candidates may begin to hang posters and utilize social media
 - In order for a party to begin campaigning, all members of the party must have attended a rules reading.
- March 29 – Filing deadline for Presidential and Vice Presidential Candidates
- April 5 – Filing deadline for all other Candidates (Senate and Boards)
- April 7 – Presidential and Vice Presidential Debate (and Fee Increase Open Forum, if necessary)
 - Location TBD, with Virtual Capability– 12:00 pm
- April 12-13 – Election
 - Voting open from 8:00 a.m. on Monday, April 12 – 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 13, at www.mnsu.edu/voting
- April 15 – All campaign materials must be removed.
