Minnesota requires all car and motorcycle owners to have **no-fault, liability, and uninsured motorist insurance**. You must carry proof of insurance in your car at all time. Driving without proof of insurance can get you cited for a misdemeanor.

III. What are the Identification Requirements?

- Passport
- I-94
- I-20
- SSN
 - If you do not possess a U.S. Social Security Card, you may request a transcript with a letter verifying your date of birth and enrollment at the Registrar's Office. The Driver's License officials will accept the two items together in a sealed envelope.
- Foreign Driver's license (optional)

IV. How much does it cost?

- Payment for a new Driver's License is \$25.25
- MN Identification Card fee is \$19.25
