When committed to film recycling, it was intended to be pilot in main floor of library Collected over 100 pounds of plastic just around library

Total from 3,000 pounds with Mankato area zero waste (500 to qualify for free bench) Echo food shelf will get first bench

On campus there is still interest

Perhaps a student group could do our own collection and earn our own benches This program is new and unique – goes directly to manufacturer – no middle steps Check bin once a week

Jeff Jeremiason coordinates student interns at Gustavus - earned 5-6 benches With more students involved, it would be less intensive – get assistance from facilities Anne and Michael drop off at Cub Foods

Set up one other location and see how it works

Lou - Students would be interested in because it is hands on classes – students want hands-on activities

Could tag on with sustainability certificate

Lou – Hyvee has bins where you drop bags – information on bins – takes plastic and give it to Trex?

Betty Winkworth tried to get an initiative to get rid of plastic bags in Mankato

Trex pays Hyvee and Cub for plastic Cub and HyVee transport for other collection efforts Shrink film takes up a lot of volume If did waste sort, we could see if there would be savings

Trex makes benches and lumber

By the Yard uses recycled milk jugs

Next month, further study of sustainability coordinator – permanently oversees the projects that we initiate

AASHE – sustainability coordinator – 80% of coordinators funded from the general fund
