## Lactation Spaces

- Centennial Student Union room 217 – a lockable room within the Women’s Restroom
- Centennial Student Union room 218 – a private office in the Women’s Center, by request only
- Earley Center for the Performing Arts room 204 – a curtained area outside of the Women’s Restroom
- Highland Center – Mamava Lactation Pod, main floor by the indoor track and Einstein Bagels. Download Mamava App to access pod, or enter code 8008# on keypad.
- Memorial Library – request a private study room at the Circulation Desk
- MavPods – various locations around campus. To make a MavPod more private for pumping or nursing, contact the Women’s Center (CSU 218) for a suction cup privacy curtain, freezable cooler bag, and sanitizer wipes.

## Minnesota State Policy Lactation Space Access

Each university shall provide access to dedicated lactation spaces that are functional, appropriate, and safe for the sole purpose of providing clean, private, secure spaces to express milk. The lactation space must:

- Be in close proximity to work or class areas
- Be a room or space other than a bathroom or toilet stall
- Be shielded from view
- Be secure and free from intrusion from employees, students, and the public
- Include an electrical outlet
- Be clean, safe, and free of hazardous materials

- Be accessible to those with disabilities
- Include a place to sit and a flat surface for personal items
- Include access to a sink with running water within 100 feet of the space
- Include access to information regarding pregnant and parenting student protections
