# What is PSEO?

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- Postsecondary enrollment option allows eligible high school students the chance to take college courses at no cost
- Students earn both high school and college credit simultaneously
- Students can take classes on the MSU campus or online



# Benefits of PSEO

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- Helps students prepare for the rigor and speed of postsecondary courses
- A chance to transition to college with the support of a familiar home environment
- Introduces new cultures to prepare students for a global society
- Promotes self-advocacy
- Access to university resources



# Financial Coverage

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- Tuition & fees
- Required textbooks
  
- Students save up to **\$9,200** per year through participation in PSEO



# The University

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- Minnesota State University, Mankato
- 4-year public institution
- 14,500 students
- 20:1 student to faculty ratio
- Division I & Division II sports



# Admission Requirements

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- **Seniors**

- Class rank top 50% **OR**
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher **OR**
- 21 or higher composite ACT score

- **Juniors**

- Class rank top 1/3 **OR**
- Cumulative GPA of 3.3 or higher **OR**
- 24 or higher composite ACT score



# Applying for PSEO

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- **Required items:**
  - 1. Online application
  - 2. High school transcript
  - 3. Notice of Student Registration Form
- Fall semester deadline: April 1
- Spring semester deadline: October 1



# Admission Decisions

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
- Admission application processing can generally take 20-25 business days
- Admission decisions are sent to a student's email



# PSEO Enrollment

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
- Orientation opens May 1
  - D2L self-paced, online
- Registration opens July 29
  - Online registration
- Fall 2024 semester start: August 26
- Spring 2025 semester start: January 13

# Registration Dates

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Registration Date & Time	Credits
Monday, July 29 <sup>th</sup> at 10:00am	20+ earned university credits (point-earners not included)
Monday, July 29 <sup>th</sup> at 12:00pm	20+ credits (includes point-earners)
Tuesday, July 30 <sup>th</sup> at 10:00am	12-19 credits (includes point earners)
Tuesday, July 30 <sup>th</sup> at 12:00pm	1-11 credits (includes point earners)
Wednesday, July 31 <sup>st</sup> at 10:00am	Students with 0 credits

# Registration Timeline

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- Registration is remote
- We recommend registering no later than Monday, **August 12<sup>th</sup>**
- You can add/remove classes from your schedule through Friday, **August 30<sup>th</sup>**



# Registration Guidelines

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- **PSEO students can register for the following:**
  - Up to 18 credits per semester
  - 100-200 level general education courses
  - Classes that do not exceed \$100 in additional fees
- **PSEO students cannot register for the following:**
  - 300-400 upper division courses
  - Classes that exceed \$100 in additional fees
  - Courses below 100 level or developmental courses



# How to Prepare for Registration

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- **Meet with your high school guidance counselor** to determine what classes you should be taking to meet high school graduation requirements
- **Prioritize required high school classes** when registering
- Log-in to e-services prior to registration day and **come-up with multiple plans** for your schedule
- Take classes that are purposeful
