Purpose of form:

Non-US citizens must have proof of filing for immigrant/permanent resident status in order to be considered candidates for tuition in-state residency. This form and the documentation required allow the International Center (*formerly the International Student Office*) to determine your immigration status within the U.S. An additional application for <u>Minnesota</u> residency must be filed with this form in the Office of the Registration and Academic Records.

Notice to Student: Some information requested on this form is classified as private. You are not legally required to provide the information; however, failure to provide it will prevent your request from being considered. Information required on this form will be used only by officials of Minnesota State University, Mankato.

This request must be submitted at least ten days prior to the effective semester.

- I-131 Advanced Parole travel document
- EAD for employment authorization

Note: Due to the fluctuation of processing times and delays **in** granting PR that are beyond the individual's control, some cases of pending permanent resident status will be considered as residents; however, even if the ISO approves the case as PR pending, all other residence requirements for in-state (Minnesota) tuition will still apply. Also, until the actual permanent resident status is approved by the Department of Homeland Security/USCIS, the student may not be eligible for any federal/state financial aid/assistance.
