READY TO MOVE-IN, MAVERICKS?

Contact your roommate to introduce yourself and discuss what you/they are planning to bring. Avoid doubling up on common items (futon, fridge, etc.)

MOVING IN



We provide flatbed carts for your use.



Follow the directions on the Move-In map for your assigned residence community.



Students should check-in at their residence community lobby upon arrival (bring photo ID).



Fill out a Room Condition Report (RCR) when you arrive to your room. Students are required to assess the condition of their room upon receiving a room key. Failure to do this will result in a \$25 administrative charge.



Microwaves must be 1,000 watts or less.



Compact refrigerators should be no greater than 1.2 Amps (or 4.3 cubic feet).

LEAVE AT HOME

Prohibited Items

- Pets (except fish, 30-gallon max tank size).
- Alcohol (including empty, decorative containers that once-contained alcohol).
- Hoverboard
- Candles, incense, or other fire hazards.
- Tobacco (including E-cigs)
- Weapons & firearms
- Space heater
- Toaster/oven
- Hot plate/burner
- Pizza baker/carousel

LIVING ON CAMPUS

Furniture in room (per person)

- XL twin-size adjustable loft & mattress *except Stadium Heights single rooms have a full-size bed & mattress).*
- Desk with chair
- Closet or wardrobe
- Dresser

Provided Utilities/Amenities

- Internet & streaming
- Electricity, gas, water
- Air-conditioned lounges
- Free laundry
- Close to Dining Center/Library (main campus)
- Ride the bus for free (bus shelters close to all residence communities!)

BED LOFTS

- Twin bed lofts in Crawford, McElroy, Julia Sears, Preska, & Stadium Heights double-as-single rooms will be lofted when students arrive.
- Bed height can be adjusted and two lofts can even be bunked together.
- Note that all bed parts need to stay in the room, as we don't provide storage.
- Adjusting your loft is a 2-person job. If you would prefer to have our staff adjust the height of the loft, submit a Maintenance Request.
