Election Timeline

- January 8, 2024 Candidacy application made available
- TBD Rules readings
 - Rules readings will <u>NOT</u> be required of individual candidates; however, parties must have at least one (1) member attend a reading to be scheduled with the elections commissioner or their designee, or an open rules reading meeting
 - Meetings will be held in the student government conference room (CSU 280) and on Zoom.
- March 23, 2024 Campaigning Begins
 - o Candidates may begin to hang posters and utilize social media
- March 25, 2024 Filing deadline for Presidential and Vice-Presidential Candidates.
 - Deadline for full parties, or for independent candidates for President/Vice President (pairs not running with a party) to submit approved poster/handout design and take advantage of the printing subsidy from Student Government.
- April 1, 2024 Filing deadlines for all other Candidates (Senate and Boards)
 - Deadline for independent candidates for Senator or Board positions to submit approved poster/handout design and take advantage of the printing subsidy from Student Government.
- April 3, 2024 Presidential and Vice-Presidential Candidate Forum (and Fee Increase Open Forum, if necessary)
 - Location TBD, with Virtual Capability—12:00 pm
- April 8-9, 2024 Election
 - Voting open from 8:00 a.m. on Monday, April 8 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 9, at www.mnsu.edu/voting
- April 11, 2024 All campaign materials must be removed.
